The copies will be sent to the jury together with a report made by the Director of the Thesis in which he will evaluate the job carried out by the student, the results achieved and the publications which the Program led to. The jury's decision (approved, given back, or rejected) cannot be appealed. If the Thesis is approved, the jury will set a date and time within a maximum of 30 days, in which the student will defend his/her Thesis orally and publicly. The mark assessment will be: Outstanding, Distinguished, Pass or Fail.
