### **Architect – 6 years**

#### **Objectives:**

The course of studies is aimed at training professionals that will be able to organize and shape the spaces where human beings' lives develop. This implies an accurate command of building, an integrative conception of humanistic and technical disciplines that merge in the training of Architects, and a developed capacity for creating, imagining and designing spaces for present and future uses and functions.

The core in the training of architects is the learning of mechanisms to project and build architectural works in different contexts and complexities. Apart from the specific teaching of architectonic projects as a core of the syllabus, technology, history, morphology and drawing are topics that define the contents of the course.

#### **Job Opportunities**

An Architect has skills and competences that define its technical, commercial or artistic activity. Its occupational field embraces:

- The project, direction and building of public and private spaces, buildings and their facilities
- The documentation, study, programming and planning of urban works and enterprises
- The investigation, theory and criticism of the human habitat, technology and the environment.
- Technical consultancy and advice concerning the financial and real state issues, technical and legal expertise, and the diagnosis and processing of building pathologies.
- The administrative, institutional and cultural management in both public and private spheres
- Teaching scientific, technical, humanistic and artistic subjects concerning its area of interest.

This professional development can be made both in public and private areas. In the private sphere, both individually and participating in architecture studios. In the industrial field, architects can work as technicians in research and production of materials. Besides, they can join real state management and urban development.

In the public sector, they can take part of national, provincial or municipal projects, and the design or planning of public space.
