

Licentiate in Art**Licentiate in Art – 5 years****High School and University/ College Teacher of Art – 5 years****Objective:**

To provide students with a sound grounding of fundamental knowledge centred in a training which avoids encyclopaedic rigidity and allows them to choose from the orientations proposed by the course of studies.

Contents

The course of studies is made up of a group of basic subjects, some compulsory, some optional and others that correspond to the oriented cycles. The orientations offered at present are: Classic Art, Modern Art and Linguistics, each of which groups its subjects by areas. The syllabus tends to guarantee a balance between the traditional conception of language and literature studies and the existence of new disciplines that meet current needs, being careful not to set limitations to working fields that students might find interesting.

Two different degrees can be obtained depending on the choice that students make at the final stage. In order to obtain the Licentiate Degree students are required to attend two seminars and hand in the corresponding Papers. For getting the Teaching Degree, they have to attend two pedagogical subjects.

Job Opportunities

Graduates develop their activities mainly in areas connected to teaching and research.

They can also work in publishing houses and the media (giving advice in publishing works, writing texts and material of different kinds, organizing and following up publications or audio visual emissions). Another non-conventional aspect that graduates are qualified to work on is the training of personnel in the accurate use of language as an instrument of communication both in public and private companies.
