Licentiate in History – 5 years
High School and University/College Teacher of History – 5 years

Objective

To provide training that will allow students to approach in a systematic and methodological way the diverse economic, social and political aspects that converge in historic events, so that graduates will be able to transmit and to produce knowledge concerning the subject.

Contents

Students have to attend, apart from the common basic cycle, a cycle of 17 subjects and then choose one of the six orientations: Ancient History; Medieval History; Modern History, Contemporary History; Argentine History and American History. Besides, they have to attend thematic and research seminars and three levels of two modern languages (Italian, French, Portuguese or English).

In order to obtain the Licentiate Degree, students have to do a thesis. For the Teaching Degree, it is necessary to pass two pedagogical subjects.

Job opportunities

Graduates can work as high school, college or university teachers. They are qualified to carry out research in diverse research centres of history and social sciences. They can also do technical tasks and provide assistance in National and Municipal Museums of general and regional history and in national, provincial and municipal historic archives.
