**Objective**

To train students in the planning and design of outdoor spaces integrating the natural and the human-built environments. To train them so that they will be able to establish links with other scientific and social disciplines in order to carry out the planning and design of outdoor spaces. To promote, foster, develop and spread awareness of the environmental problems and the use human beings make of it.

**Contents**

The core subject is "Introduction to Landscape Design and Planning", which starts with an introductory course, and develops with three Design courses and a Final Paper in which the knowledge acquired in subjects such as Botanic, Chemistry, Morphology, Environmental Sciences, History, Urban and Regional Planning, and Weather sciences, among others, should be reflected.

**Job Opportunities**

Licentiatees in Landscape Planning and Design can work in Landscape and Urbanism Planning and Design Studies, as Design Chiefs, or as members of teams or consultancies. They can also work in companies as planners, creative designers, advisors, builders or technical representatives. Besides, they can develop an academic career in universities and institutes as teachers or researchers.
