

Licentiate in Nursing
Licentiate in Nursing – 4 years
University Nurse – 2 ½ years

Objectives

To train students in basic nursing assistance, in medical assistance services and health programmes.

Contents

The course is made up of two successive cycles: once the first is finished (between 2 and 2 ½ years of duration) students obtain the degree of Nurse; in the second cycle the previous studies are seen in more depth with specializations in Nurse of High Risk and Teaching and Administration of Nursing Services. When the second cycle is finished, the degree of Licentiate in Nursing is awarded.

Job Opportunities

Nursing involves functions such as health promotion, recovery and rehabilitation as well as illness prevention. Graduates can also teach, carry out research and provide advice on issues concerning their field. Professionals can work for assistance, official, private or public institutions. Other spheres that concern Nurses working fields are teaching at schools and participating in programs of sanitary assistance to the community.
