

Occupational Therapy

Licentiate in Occupational Therapy – 4 years

Objectives

To train graduates that will be qualified to carry out health promotion, prevention and recovery actions through the analysis and application of Self-maintenance, Productivity, Playing and Free time as members of inter and multidisciplinary teams. Its objective is to analyse and instrument human beings' occupations connected to the development of the areas of Self-maintenance, Productivity and Free time, to promote, maintain and recover health. It develops prevention and rehabilitation actions in the areas of health, Work, Social Safety, Special Education and Social Action.

Contents

The course of studies is made up of 23 subjects, apart from the ones corresponding to the Common Basic Cycle. The training includes 1000 hours of professional practice.

Working Field

Graduates are qualified to: carry out health promotion, prevention and rehabilitation through the analysis, application and evaluation of Self-maintenance, productivity, Playing and Free Time occupations. They can design and implement methods and evaluation, maintenance and development techniques of the functional psychological, physical and social capacity of human beings as members of inter and multidisciplinary teams. They can detect and evaluate development disruptions at an early stage and carry out early stimulation. Besides, they can design, elaborate and participate in the evaluation of orthopaedic equipment; design, elaborate and evaluate personal and environmental adaptations aimed at fostering the autonomy of handicapped people. They can participate in planning, execution and evaluation of plans, project and programmes.

Graduates work in: Health centres, Rehabilitation Centres; Hospitals; Special Schools; Prison Institutions, etc.
