- Give advice as regards the planning, design, interpretation and application of current legislation to information systems, data processing and communication, both in the public and private sector.
- Participate in teams with interdisciplinary approaches in projects that require the professional integration of specialists in systems with other areas of knowledge.
- Foster the development and improvement of the profession
